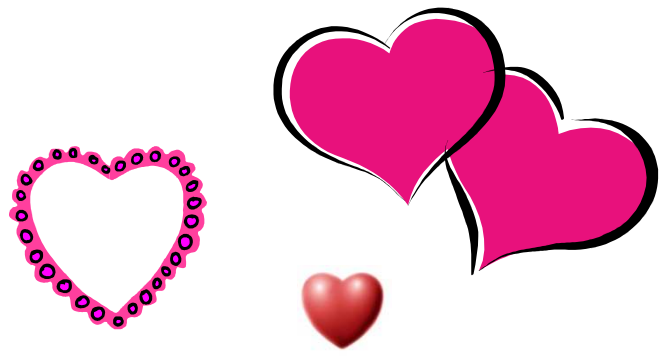


February News
