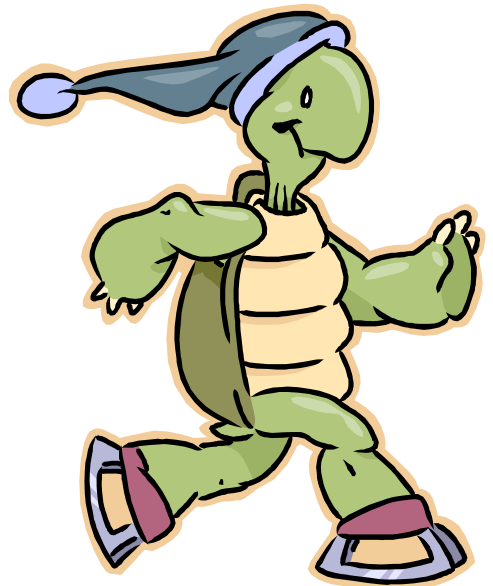


## Valentine's Party - February 14, 2012
