

Primary Year End Trip to Safari Niagara - Wednesday June 12th.



Students in Grades 1, 2 and 3 will be travelling by bus to Safari Niagara on Wednesday, June 12th. The bus will leave Jacob Beam at 9:00 am and will return to school at 2:30 pm for regular dismissal.

Students will tour the 150-acre animal park with over 1000 animals, see educational "Keeper Talks" and ride the Gator Express Tram.

We will meet for a bagged lunch.

No purchases may be made throughout the day, please do not bring money.

We will need parent volunteers for this trip. Parent Volunteers will be responsible for a small group of children. Please check the box below and you will be notified to confirm your participation.

Parent volunteers- please refrain from buying your group any treats, leave siblings at home. Parent Volunteers are more than welcome to stay after we board the bus with their own child/children and continue to enjoy the day. In that case, please drive your own car.

The cost for this trip is \$16 for students and \$21 for parents.
